SUMMARY

"During our activities with young people, in the last couple of years there were many situations in which they (Roma young people) requested our support to choose a faculty or to find a suitable job after finishing their studies. The pandemic has deepened even more their isolation&need for support and we started receiving more&more questions."

"Our project, Together we create the path, was created to cover a common need identified by the 3 organizations involved:

developing our capacity to support career orientation for Roma young people and other minorities through transnational cooperation

1. Mapping the methods used in each partner country to guide Roma and other minorities in career orientation. The outcome

is a comparative methodology between the 3 countries compiling all existing methods into a report.



2. Developing career orientation knowledge and skills for 15 members of the 3 organization through 1 training and 2 workshops during the projec

3. Exchange transnational career orientation good practices between the 3 organ. in order to gather best methods and tools into a toolkit.

What will you learn? Testilis

- How to evaluate someone in order to establish his/her professional profile;
- How to assess the person's type of personality, occupational interests and skills in order to complete the jobseeker's professional profile;
- Identify the training needs of the person looking for a job and recommending professional training programs, identify the employment difficulties faced by the person looking for a job;
- Establish a set of career goals and action plan with the job seeker.

- *Main focus:* improve the knowledge of the participants on career orientation for minorities
- *Participants:* 5 from each organisation (Spain, Romania, Turkiye)
- When & where: Iasi, Romania, 8-9 April, travel days: 7st April and I0th April

Profile participants

Minimum selection criteria for young participants:

- ✓ young people between the ages of 18-30;
- ✓ to be from disadvantaged backgrounds;
- ✓ to be part of an ethnic minority category;
- ✓ to want to pass on the information received during the course to other young people;
- ✓ to be open to new ideas and to be interested in developing their skills in relation to the project's objectives.

- ✓ participants will have to attend all the sessions of the course (the sessions are mandatory), then the project activities;
- ✓ participants must be motivated to work on the topic addressed by the project;
- ✓ have minimal knowledge about Erasmus+
 projects;
- ✓ be open to the topic and empathize with the other participants.

2. Otopeni Airport (Bucharest)


If you choose Otopeni airport, you will have to take a bus to the city of Iasi
